Proper Bibliographic Reference Format: Bibliographic references are double-spaced and indented half an inch after the first line. If there is no author, the article title comes first. For titles of newspapers, use italics and "headline" style capitalization. Use the URL of the homepage of the newspaper to avoid non-working URLs.
