Historic properties either retain integrity (this is, convey their significance) or they do not. Within the concept of integrity, the National Register criteria recognizes seven aspects or qualities that, in various combinations, define integrity. To retain historic integrity a property will always possess several, and usually most, of the aspects.

The key duties of the board include: review of National Register of Historic Places nominations for accuracy and adequacy; review and comment about the state's comprehensive statewide historic preservation plan and the state's annual historic preservation fund grant program; and general advice and guidance to the State Historic Preservation ...
