Requires a minimum of 30 hours of flight training. The aircraft a Recreational Pilot flies is limited to 180 horsepower, and can only fly at a maximum altitude of 2000 AGL. The Recreational Pilot requires a 3rd class medical. Recreational pilots typically fly from their "home airport", fly during the day, and with only one additional passenger.

Recreational Pilot Permit (RPP) The RPP is not a licence, but a pilot permit. The holder of an RPP may fly a single engine, non-high performance aircraft with a seating capacity of not more than four (including flight crew) under day VFR conditions, and may carry not more than one passenger.
