Small society lotteries. Small society lotteries can only be run in support of good causes, such as charity fundraising and cannot be run for private or commercial gain. Ticket sales in a single lottery cannot be more than £20,000. In a calendar year that total must not be more than £250,000.

A society's lottery must conform to these rules: (1) The lottery must be promoted by a member of the society who has been authorised in writing to act as the promoter. (2) Each ticket distributed or sold must specify the name of the society, the name and address of the promoter and the date of the lottery.

Players of People's Postcode Lottery raised £93.3m in 2017, an increase from £6.1m five years before and its trusts have awarded over £40m since 2009 to small charities.
