To reinstate it, you must go back to the file menu and protect the workbook again. Protect a Worksheet from Editing. You can also protect individual worksheets from editing. When you protect a worksheet, Excel locks all of the cells from editing. Protecting your worksheet means that no one can edit, reformat, or delete the content.
